



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


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INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION

- 1. Turn power OFF from the electrical panel before installation.
- 2. Use the template inside the box to cut a hole in the ceiling. (Fig. 1)





See below size of the cutout template:

4" models: 4-5/16" diameter 6" models: 6" diameter


3. Open the driver box and remove the needed knockout(s). (Fig. 2)





4. Insert the electrical supply cable through the knockout and secure with a terminal. Wire driver box (*Fig. 3*), white - white, black - black, green - green/ground.





5. Place all wiring and connections back into the box, close the cover and select desired color temperature (CCT). (Fig. 4)






INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION (cont'd)


6. Place the driver box into the ceiling and connect the fixture to driver box. (Fig. 5)

7. Lift both retention tabs upward, push until the trim sits flush against the ceiling. (Fig. 6)
